Main duties include the following.

- 1. Holding of weekly 1.5-hour labs** (12 weeks in total, 2 TAs per lab, 50 students max)
[For 45-hour contracts: 36 hours (2 labs per week, 24 labs in total)]
[For 65-hour contracts: 54 hours (3 labs per week, 36 labs in total)]
[For 90-hour contracts: 72 hours (4 labs per week, 48 labs in total)]
- 2. Assistance with marking midterm and final exam (about 2 hours for each lab)**
[For 45-hour contracts: 6 hours (4 hours for 2 labs, 1 hour extra for midterm and final)]
[For 65-hour contracts: 8 hours (6 hours for 3 labs, 1 hour extra for midterm and final)]
[For 90-hour contracts: 10 hours (8 hours for 4 labs, 1 hour extra for midterm and final)]
- 3. Preparation and other communication with instructor, peers and students** [3 hours]
- 4. Additional Duties for Lead TAs** [for 90-hour contracts only, 5 hours]
